Resident Students

The cost of meals, on Monday to Friday inclusive, is incorporated in the annual residential charge, payable in three instalments, at the beginning of each term. There is no rebate for missed meals although initial costings take into account that a number of meals will not be taken. Resident students will be provided with identity cards that must be produced, at all meals and shown to catering staff on request.

Non-Resident Students

- (a) May purchase meals in the dining room as required. Dishes are priced individually.
