FROM AUGUST

- Accept accommodation offer and pay the deposit
- Enrol online
- Upload photo for ID card
- Register your car for parking
- Check your student finance application is correct and start planning your budget

FROM SEPTEMBER

- Pack your stuff (check joining instructions on website for any course-specific items)
- Pay fees / set up payment plan for fees (if you/your parents are funding this)
- Have enough funds in place to live on until your Student Loan arrives (around 5 days after registration day)
- Make a travel plan for Registration day

ON ARRIVAL AT HARPER

- Arrive and register in person on campus
- Remember to bring your ID if you have been asked to do so
- Collect ID card
- Pay anything outstanding to Harper
- Meet your halls of residence Student Life Rep (SLR) to collect your keys (they will be the ones in orange at the front of each hall!) If you live off campus, you will be able to meet your designated off campus SLR when you register
- Make sure you ask any questions you have, or seek out a member of staff/an SLR if you are nervous or need some help. The Hi Point in Student Services (1st Floor Faccenda) will be open all week and is a good starting point for anything you need!
